

Bylaw No. 6/87

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The council of the Rural Municipality of Leask No. 464, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
  - a. “curb” shall mean the lateral boundaries of a highway, whether or not marked by curbing;
  - b. “highway” means any public highway within the municipality under the direction, control and management of the municipality and “public highway” means a public highway as defined by or pursuant to The Highway Traffic Act;
  - c. “motor vehicle” means a motor vehicle as defined by or pursuant to The Highway Traffic Act;
  - d. “parking” shall mean the standing of a motor vehicle, whether occupied or not, upon a highway, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading, or in obedience to traffic regulations, traffic signs or signals, or the direction of a traffic officer or constable.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle under his control be parked on any highway, except as may be authorized by this Bylaw.
3. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle under his control to stand unattended on any highway, unless such motor vehicle shall first have been parked in the manner as provided in this bylaw.
4. Subject to the provisions of Sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 hereof the parking of motor vehicles is hereby permitted on all highways.
5. Pursuant to Section 40 of The Highway Traffic Act, and this bylaw, no persons shall stop or park a motor vehicle on any public highway, outside of a hamlet, within 30 meters of another motor vehicle stopped or parked on the opposite side of the highway.
6. No person shall park a motor vehicle on any highway except in the following manner, to wit: such motor vehicle shall be drawn up to the curb and with the right front and rear wheels at a distance not more than thirty centimeters from the curb.
7. No motor vehicle shall be parked on any highway with the engine running, unless the same is under the control of a licensed operator.
8. No motor vehicle used, designed or intended for the conveyance of inflammable, combustible, explosive or other dangerous materials, whether loaded or unloaded, shall be parked at any time upon a highway except for the sole purpose of, and only for the time necessary to receive or deliver orders.
9. Vehicles are prohibited from parking at any time on any portion of a highway or highways specified in Schedule A attached to and forming part of this bylaw. Every area where parking is so prohibited shall be designated by the erection and maintenance therein of suitable signs or markers, clearly visible from the travelled portion of the highway, showing that parking in such area is prohibited.
10. No person shall park a motor vehicle at any time within any area where parking has been prohibited in accordance with section 8.
11. No person shall deface, injure, destroy, or remove any sign or marker erected in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.
12. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
13. Bylaw No. 7/85 is hereby repealed.

SCHEDULE "A" TO BYLAW 6/87

PROHIBITED PARKING LOCATION

1. Parking is hereby prohibited on the section of the registered roadway located a distance of 100 metres in each direction from the bridge on SE-24-48-8 W3 and shown as part of registered road plan No. 85 B 02451.
