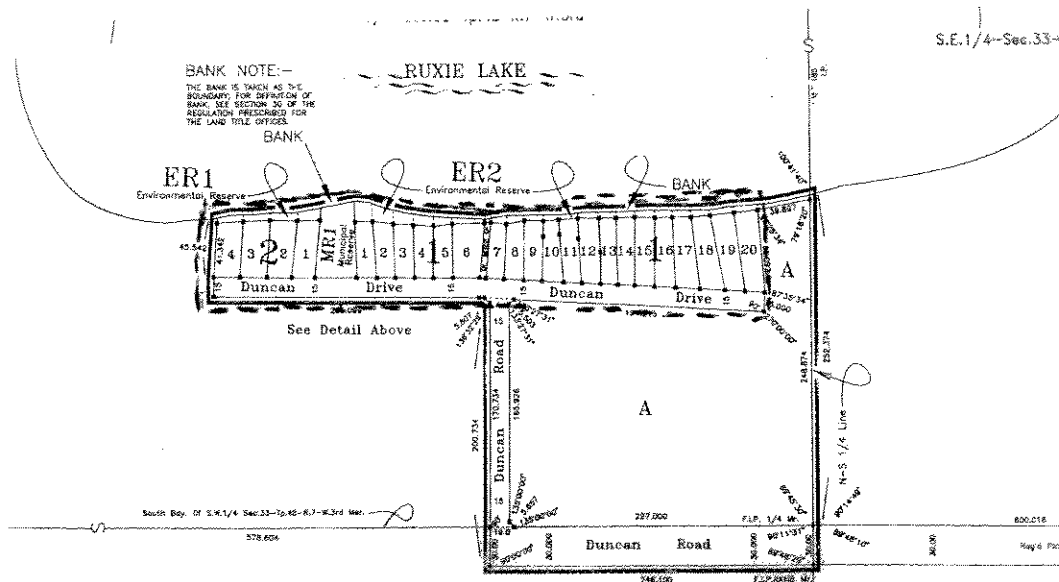


NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

Pursuant to The Municipalities Act, public notice is hereby given that the Hamlet of Duncan's Beach intends to become established as the Organized Hamlet of Duncan's Beach.

The Hamlet of Duncan's Beach, Plan #02B08854, excluding Parcel A and Duncan Road, indicated by the bold dashed line, is located within the Rural Municipality of Leask No. 464 within Southeast Section 33, Township 48, Range 7, West of the 3rd Meridian.



The reasons for the proposal are:

- Currently operating as a Hamlet and recognized as such by the R.M. of Leask
- Because we have been recognized as a Hamlet for over 20 years and established a water system, street lighting, garbage disposal, road maintenance, boat launch, and purchased an AED (defibulator) we require funding to maintain these services. 50% of our cottage owners and some family members have recently certified in CPR and AED use. We have plans in place for future CPR certification and recertification as well as the training and certification of water system operation.
- Historically we have shown to be fiscally responsible
 - A - built up reserve fund
 - B - maintained a positive bank balance for day to day expenses
 - C - bills have been paid before submission for reimbursement from reserve fund.
- To insure that a portion of our Municipal Tax dollars collected are returned to the Hamlet to maintain the current level of services.

A public meeting will be held on September 14, 2011 from 9:00 - 9:15 a.m. at R.M. of Leask No. 464 council chambers to discuss the proposal.

Any persons who wish to object to the proposed restructuring may file a written objection, stating clearly their reason for their opposition, with the administrator of the Rural Municipality of Leask No. 464 at the address below:

A written notice of objection must be received by the administrator by September 23, 2011.
