**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**Leask Sports Arena**

Public notice is hereby given that the Council for the Village of Leask intends to proceed with the decommissioning of the Leask Sports Arena facility. The utilities will be turned off, the building secured and will no longer be available for rent or use. At this time, there are no immediate plans to demolish or otherwise dispose of the building.

The declining use of the facility, NWRC no longer requiring space for classes, along with the ever-increasing cost of upkeep and utilities, has lead to this decision.

Council will hold a Public Hearing on July 18, 2018 from 7 to 7:30 pm at the Village Office to hear any person or group that wants to comment on the proposed action.
