**2015 TAXES**

Tax time is upon us once again and notices will be sent the first week of July 2015 and are due by December 31, 2015. On April 15, 2015, Council approved the 2015 Budget and set the mill rate.

The following municipal rates are applicable for 2015:

Municipal mill rate changed from 8.5 mills to 9 mills

The government made no changes to the education tax for the 2015 tax year which remains as follows:

Agricultural Land: 2.67 mill	Commercial/Industrial Property: Other is set at 8.28 mill
Residential Property: 5.03 mill	Commercial/Industrial Property: Resource set at 11.04 mill

**CHECKLIST:**

✓ **Building Permit**

Building permits are required for all building, moving and demolition. Please contact the Village Office before you start your project to obtain the necessary forms. The forms can also be printed off the Village website – look under Building Permits on the Question & Answer page.

✓ **Development Permit**

Development Applications are required for buildings, garages and additions, fences, decks etc and are available at the Village Office or on the Question & Answer page of the website – Development Permits.

Please contact the Village Office if you have any questions as to whether a

Development Application is required for your project or business

✓ **Measure your lot and know your lot lines**

Measure twice and build once! Locating your pins and measuring your lot will ensure that your construction project will not encroach on lot lines. You will need this information for your Development Permit. Village staff cannot assist with the locating of your pins but we do have a metal detector we can make available to you with prior notice.

✓ **Business License**

Ensure that your contractor and trades persons, if they do not reside in the Village, have obtained a license to conduct business within the Village from the Village Office.
