### Recycling Program – Update

The recycling program got underway on  
September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2014 and is running smoothly.

**You will notice a charge of \$2.20 added to your  
water bills. Debit customers will see an  
adjustment to the withdrawal amount.**

\*\*Please be sure to set your recycling out  
first thing in the morning or even the night before  
as maintenance is finding it takes less time to pick  
up recycling and often get to your homes sooner  
than they do on regular garbage days.

\*\*We have confirmed that glass jars and  
bottles can be placed in your recycling... no mirror,  
window glass etc.

\*\*Lids are not required for the recycling  
bins, so none have been ordered or are available.  
It is not a concern if contents become wet from  
snow or rain and if wind creates a problem,  
Council will review the issue further at that time.

If you would like another recycling bin, they are  
available for purchase at cost of \$10.75 per bin.  
Please contact the Village Office to order.
